NOW COMES Intervenor-Plaintiff Aaron M. Frey, Attorney General of the State of Maine (the Attorney General), and moves this Court, pursuant to M.R. Civ. P. 6(b) and 7, to further enlarge the deadline to answer or respond to the City of Belfast's counterclaim dated January 11, 2022, until 45 days after the date of the Court's order(s) deciding the Attorney General's Consented-To Motion to Enter and Make Findings on the Parties' Stipulated Judgment and Dismissal Without Prejudice. All other parties consent to this motion and the Attorney General's requested relief. In support of this motion the Attorney General states as follows:

On January 26, 2022, the Court granted the Attorney General's prior motion to enlarge the deadline to answer or respond to the City's counterclaim to February 28, 2022, to allow for settlement discussions. As a result of those discussions, the parties have agreed to and executed a

Stipulated Judgment and Dismissal Without Prejudice (the Stipulation) that, if approved by this Court, would resolve the two counts pleaded in the Attorney General's complaint and the City's counterclaim against the Attorney General and obviate the need for the Attorney General to answer or otherwise respond to the City's counterclaim.

Thus, the Attorney General moves this Court for an additional enlargement of the deadline to answer or otherwise respond to the City's counterclaim in the event the Court either does not act on or denies the Attorney General's motion regarding the Stipulation by the current answer/response deadline of February 28, 2022. Specifically, the Attorney General moves this Court to extend until 45 days after the date of the Court's order(s) on the Stipulation the Attorney General's deadline for answering or otherwise responding to the City's counterclaim.

Counsel for the City, plaintiffs, and Nordic Aquafarms, Inc. each represent that they consent to this motion and the Attorney General's requested relief.
